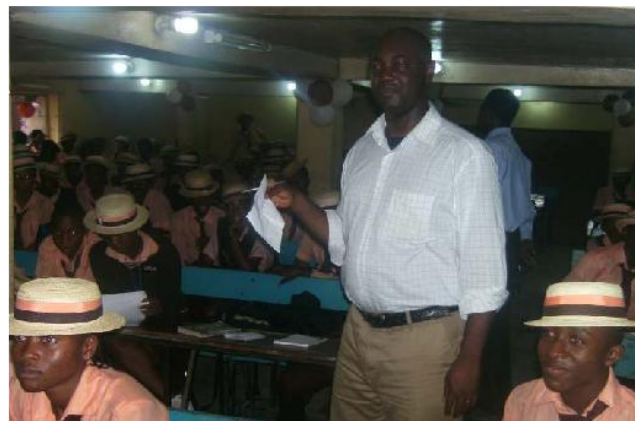


LEADERSHIP SEMINARS in Secondary Schools
